Mayor Leffingwell, Mayor Pro Tem Martinez, and Council Members,

Recent misinterpretations or flagrant disregard for the letter and intent of an adopted neighborhood plan and NCCD prompted the Austin Neighborhoods Council (ANC) Executive Committee to unanimously adopt the following resolution:

## **Resolution on City Planning**

**Whereas** neighborhood zoning is enabled by the adoption of a neighborhood plan, which is an amendment to the adopted comprehensive plan, per state law;

**Therefore be it resolved** that the Austin Neighborhoods Council (ANC) requests that the City respect and reflect on adopted neighborhood plans as well as the adopted comprehensive plan when interpreting adopted neighborhood zoning overlays.


Adopted by unanimous vote on 9 June 2010

The resolution will be presented for consideration on June 23 by ANC's general membership which consists of representatives from 88 neighborhood associations city-wide.

This very brief resolution reflects the seemingly endless repetition by neighborhood residents of the obvious fact that a single page future land use map (FLUM) contained in a neighborhood plan, cannot and should not be read in isolation from the plan's tens or dozens of pages of recommendations and action items derived over months or even years of planning by neighborhood residents and City planning staff.
